Case Study #1 Donor

- 64 yo female
- 5 ft 7 in; 175 lbs
- Tripped and fell; SDH
- Local; 30 minutes travel time
- TTE: 55%; LVEDD 3.8 cm; LVPW 1.0 cm
- RHC/LHC: RA 10; PAS 22; no CAD
- Offered as #44 in the sequence

Case Study #1 Recipient

- 69 yo male
- Ht and Wt ratio: 0.9 and 1.0
- Dilated CM; nonredo
- Status II; listed 361 days
- TPG 6

Case Study #1 Outcome

- TIT: 107 minutes
- Uneventful postoperative course
- Discharged POD # 8
- More than one year out; no readmission

Case Study #2 Donor

- 20 yo male
- 5 ft 4 in; 125 lbs
- Ejected from car at high speed; pos cocaine
- Travel time: 3 hours
- TTE #1: 35%; LVEDD 4.6 cm; LVPW 0.94
- TTE #2 (24 hrs later day of procurement): 50%
- Offered as #10 in the sequence

Case Study #2 Recipient

- 19 yo female
- 5 ft 2 in; 120 lbs
- Ht/Wt: 1.0/1.0
- s/p OHT x 3; sensitized
- Status 1A; dop and dob
- Listed 452 days
- PAP: 30/18

Case Study #2 Outcome

- TIT: 323 minutes
- Stable for 90 minutes in ICU
- PGD requiring ECMO in ICU; x 7 days
- Discharged after one month
- ATG, IVIG, Eculizumab
- 3 years out; EF 60%

Case Study #3 Donor

- 42 yo male
- 5 ft 10 in; 163 lbs
- MCA; flew 20 ft; CHI
- In house
- TTE #1: 39%; LVEDD 4.4 cm; LVPW 0.9
- TTE #2: 39% (12 hours later)
- TTE #3: 46% (24 hours later
- Max troponin 42; three days later = 1.2
- Offered as #2 in the sequence

Case Study #3 Recipient

- 66 yo female
- 5 ft 8 in; 123 lbs
- Ht/Wt: 1.0/1.3
- Valvular CM; redo and on HD for H/K
- Status 1A; dop and dob
- PAP: 60/24; TPG 14

Case Study #3 Outcome

- TIT: 83 minutes
- Discharged POD # 10
- One year out; doing well
