






California's Transplant Demographic Challenge








Significantly Shorter Waiting Time in the OneLegacy DSA than Region 5 and U.S. National


Median Months to Heart Transplant








O.L. Significantly Higher % of Heart Donors as a Percent of All Donors & Eligible Donors than U.S.


How Does the OneLegacy DSA have Shorter Wait Times and Higher % of Donor Hearts Transplanted?









OneLegacy Thoracic Organs Transplanted




OneLegacy Thoracic Tx Rate vs. U.S. (% of Donors)

Increasing Authorization Rate: OneLegacy Authorization Rate Trend & U.S. Rate



2015 Authorization Rates




% of Eligible Deaths



 - To prevent early d/c of ventilatory support




DMV Donor Registration

Authorization Rate: *Broad-Based Interventions*

 Paid Media: Seldom economically viable.. eg. 2009 DLCA \$3 million, 1 month radio, tv, billboards resulted in 7/10ths% increase in 15-25yo registration rate, with likelihood that 0.5% will ever become a potential donor



 Targeted Paid Media: One published study of \$300K investment at OneLegacy showed an increase, but was confounded by simultaneous introduction of Hispanic Family Care Staff...






Tomorrow will mark the third week our Embajadores de OneLegacy have been able to utilize the OneLegacy eRegistration Devices in the consulates!



Increasing Organs/Donors: Donor Management

Tele-Medicine-Enabled Intensivist

Intervention 1: OneLegacy developed the world's first Electronic Donor Record/organ offer system in 2001. Since 2009 OneLegacy has utilized its proprietary 'digitalDonor' Electronic Donor Record web access to enable Intensivists and transplant teams to assess organ viability via first-hand review of lab results, CT and X-Ray imaging, echocardiogram and cine films, biopsy slides, and clinical history throughout the donor management period.


increase lung function and thoracic utilization and who resides 3,700km from Los Angeles in Baltimore Maryland. The Intensivist reviews each case via digitalDonor and telephonic consult with

the OneLegacy Procurement Coordinator in the donor hospital, provides APRV ventilator guidance, fluid and medication management, and direct consultation with the transplant surgeons to whom the organs are offered.




Increasing Organs /Donor: Donor Management

- Clinical Intervention
 - Ventilatory Management: APRV
 - Hespan to reduce fluid overload potential
 - Corticosteroids
 - GIK (Glucose, Insulin, Potassium) Protocol to improve metabolism of stunned myocardium and improve diastolic and systolic function
 - Cardiac Catheterization as requested
 - Time: Case times increased from 36 hours to 60 on thoracic cases to allow interventions to improve function
